HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Seniors graduating are eligible for the Don Ferrarese Charitable Scholarship in the amount of \$4,000.00, payable \$1,000 per year for college related expenses. This will be awarded to one student from each of the High Desert High Schools.

To be considered for this award, a student must be recommended by a teacher/counselor of their respective school. The award must be utilized at an accredited college, university or trade school. All applications must be received by the Foundation no later than April 30th, 2007. The basis for the award will be the student's community involvement, which may include school organizations, clubs, leadership programs, but most importantly, **charitable activities**.
